Short reply by way of affidavit of Manmohan Singh Kang, Land Acquisition Collector -cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Gurdaspur – respondent no.4 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

It is not disputed that the orders of the writ Court have been complied with. However, claims of petitioner no.27 and 29 are still pending. Qua petitioner no.27 it is stated that no land was acquired while claim of petitioner no.29 is pending on account of indemnity bond.

Since the orders of the writ Court have been largely complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such. Let claim of petitioner no.29 be also cleared as expeditiously as possible and in so far as petitioner no.27 is concerned he is at liberty to avail himself of his remedies in law.
