Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the reply/compliance report filed, the only grievance survives that no interest has been paid on the arrears.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Gautam Kumar, Assistant of Director Elementary Education, Haryana, submits that though an undertaking was given by the petitioner that she would give up interest, yet the matter as per law would be decided and order would be passed within four weeks. Further, the interest amount found due would be paid thereafter.

In view of above, petition is disposed of.

However, in case, the petitioner is aggrieved on the amount calculated by the Tribunal, she would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
