The petitioner incarcerated in the FIR captioned above, has come up before this Court under Section 483 BNSS, 2023 seeking bail.

2. Custody certificate dated 16.01.2025 filed by State counsel today in the Court are taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

3. In paragraph 10 of the petition, the petitioner has mentioned that he has no criminal history. However, State counsel submits that as per custody certificate dated 16.01.2025, one more FIR No. 21 dated 25.02.2023 registered in Police Station Sadar Sangrur under Sections 379, 411, 120-B IPC is pending against the petitioner.

4. Given above, the present petition stands dismissed. Liberty is reserved to the petitioner to file fresh petition after disclosing all criminal antecedents. Since petitioner has already given power of attorney to his counsel in this petition, as such, Registry shall not insist to file power of attorney, in case, fresh petition is filed and power of attorney filed in this petition shall suffice. All pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
