As per the observations made in the order dated 03.09.2025, despite service, the respondent did not made appearance on that date. Even today, he has not made appearance. As such, the respondent is proceeded against *ex parte*.

Counsel for the applicant heard.

The applicant-wife has filed the present application for seeking transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/1098/2022, titled '*Himanshu Gupta Vs. Roma Jindal*', filed by the respondent-husband, pending in the Family Court, Ambala and she seeks transfer of the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Tohana, District Fatehabad.

It is submitted by the counsel for the applicant that the marriage between the parties to the lis, had taken place on 07.05.2021, but no child was born from the said wedlock. On account of the matrimonial dispute, the

parties are residing separate. The applicant is not having any source of earning and is dependent upon her parental family. She has filed the petition under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, which is pending in the Courts at Tohana, District Fatehabad. The distance between Jakhal, the place of residence of the applicant and Ambala, is about 150 kilometres. In view of the constrained circumstances aforesaid, more particularly, when the applicant is not having any source of earning, it is submitted that it is difficult for her to commute such a distance, to defend the divorce petition.

In view of the aforesaid fact situation and also considering the fact about the respondent having not come forward to resist the application, the transfer application is allowed and the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/1098/2022, titled '*Himanshu Gupta Vs. Roma Jindal*', filed by the respondent-husband, stands transferred from the Family Court, Ambala, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Tohana, District Fatehabad. The requisite record of the aforesaid case be sent by the Family Court, Ambala, to the District and Sessions Judge, Fatehabad.

Learned District and Sessions Judge, Fatehabad, shall assign the said petition to the Family Court (Camp Court) Tohana. Even, the parties are directed to appear before the Family Court (Camp Court) Tohana, within a period of one month from today onwards.
