1. This is an incomplete case which is pending before this Court since 2023, and has been listed before this Court by the registry for passing appropriate orders. In fact, there is a general direction for listing all those cases, which have neither been pursued, nor the requisite corrections and the defects as pointed out by the registry, have been removed.
2. Perusal of the file reveals that the present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.31 dated 25.02.2023, under Sections 447, 427, 511 of IPC registered at Police Station Pasiana, District Patiala and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise deed dated 20.12.2023 (P-2).
3. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners despite issuance of notice and no one has turned up to meet out the objections/deficiencies, which were pointed out by the Registry, thus, present petition is hereby dismissed, same being neither valid nor prosecuted.
