1. Learned counsel representing respondent Nos.2 and 3 on instructions submits that necessary compliance of the order dated 12.09.2024 passed by the Writ Court along with release of benefits of higher pension arrears shall be complied with within a period of 03 weeks from today.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
