Notices issued to Rekha widow of deceased Mukesh (respondent No.4) has been duly served, but she has chosen not to come present. It seems that she has lost interest in the present proceedings. In fact, learned counsel for the appellants states at the bar that said respondent, after receiving major apportionment of the compensation as awarded by learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Rohtak and employment on compassionate ground in view of death of Mukesh, has left the matrimonial home leaving the present appellants in lurch.

In the circumstances, learned counsel for the appellants has discussed the matter with learned counsel for the insurance company.

A statement made on behalf of the appellants that in full and final satisfaction of their claim, an amount of Rs.2,25,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Twenty Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the tribunal be awarded and be disbursed to the appellant No.1-Kiran D/O Late Mukesh and appellant No.2-Shiva minor son of Late Mukesh in equal shares, having been accepted on behalf of the insurer of the offending vehicle, the appeal is disposed of with a direction to the insurer to deposit with the office of the Lok Adalat two cheques of equal amount (total Rs. 2,25,000/- Rupees Two Lakh Twenty Five Thousand Only), favouring the appellant No.1-Kiran D/O Late Mukesh and appellant No.2-Shiva minor son of Late Mukesh in equal shares, for & on behalf of all the appellants within 06 weeks from today, failing which the amount hereby awarded shall carry interest @ 9% per annum from the date of this order till payment thereof.

The cheques so deposited may be collected by the above-named appellants or the counsel representing the appellants against proper receipt.
