Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the impugned order dated 13.3.2025 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Gurugram, in Civil Suit No.3004/2020, titled as 'Shubham Rana vs. Advenio Tecnosys Private Limited', vide which the application moved seeking adjournment was dismissed.

It is very fairly admitted by learned counsel for the petitioner/defendant No.1, that it was the 5th opportunity sought by the petitioner for leading evidence before the learned trial Court. It is, however, submitted that on 13.3.2025 when evidence of the petitioner was closed by the impugned order, the petitioner was in genuine difficulty as he has been contesting the Municipal Councillor Elections himself. It is accordingly prayed that great injustice and loss would be caused to the petitioner in case he is not permitted to lead his evidence. Learned counsel prays that one



effective opportunity be granted to the petitioner to lead his evidence. It is submitted that the matter is now fixed before the learned trial Court for 14.5.2025.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, issuance of notice of motion is dispensed with at this stage, as it will cause further delay in disposal of the case. Accordingly, keeping in view the above facts as canvassed by learned Counsel for the petitioner, this petition is allowed and impugned order dated 13.3.2025 (Annexure P-2) is set aside. The learned Court below is directed to grant one effective opportunity to enable the petitioner herein to conclude his evidence, however subject to payment of Rs.20,000/- as costs to be paid by the petitioner herein to the respondent herein and defendant therein on or before 14.5.2025, failing which the present petition shall automatically be considered as 'dismissed'

Disposed of as above.
