1. This order of mine shall dispose of the above-mentioned five writ petitions as they arise from a similar factual matrix. However, for the sake of brevity, the facts are taken from CWP-4259-2024.
2. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of an appropriate writ or order in the nature of certiorari for quashing/setting aside the order dated 13.06.2023 passed by the Executive Officer Municipal Council Fazilka (Annexure P-10) vide which claim for grant of pension benefits to the petitioner in terms of "The Punjab Municipal Employees Pension and General Provident Funds Rules, 1994" has been rejected and further for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant and release the pension along with other retiral benefits from the date of their retirement till the payment with interest @ 18% per annum.
3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) wishes to withdraw the civil writ petition(s) with liberty to file fresh with better particulars.
4. In view of the above, all the five present writ petitions are dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid, so also the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any,
