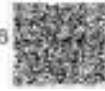

By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
229	28.05.2024	307, 506, 34 of IPC and 25 of Arms Act.	City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 13.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 13.01.2025.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. During the course of hearing on 13.01.2025, following order was passed:

“Inter-alia contends that the petitioner has been attributed the role of raising lalkara and thereafter giving beating which can at the most be simple injury, the fire arm injury has been attributed to Charanpal @ Shanty who has been granted the concession of default bail by the concerned Court & the petitioner is willing to join investigation and cooperate therein.

Adjourned to 06.02.2025.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 16.01.2025 at 11:00 A.M. in concerned Police Station and join investigation. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bond(s) to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. As and when further called by Investigating Officer, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the condition(s) enumerated under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 13.01.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 13.01.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the

evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
