AARADHNA SAWHNEY, J.(ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner is the only child of his mother. There is no else in the family to look after his ailing mother and grandmother, who are both suffering from Neurological disorders and had been admitted in Sarvodaya Hospital, Faridabad. At the time of filing this petition, however they had been discharged. Medical records appended along with the petition (Annexures P-11 and P-12) have been referred to.

Subsequently, however, the mother of the petitioner, who complained of acute chest pain had to be again hospitalized. It is in the light of submissions made herein before, coupled with treatment record of mother and grandmother of petitioner, that learned counsel prays for taking lenient view in favour of petitioner by granting him the concession of interim bail for few days to look after the ailing lady members of his family.

2. Reply on behalf of the respondent is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondent has opposed the prayer for grant of interim bail on the ground that since the mother and grandmother of petitioner have been



discharged from hospital and main petition of petitioner for grant of bail, pending before this Court for 17.10.2025, is likely to be disposed of, no case for grant of interim bail is made out.

3. Heard. Documents on record perused.

4. In view of delicate medical condition of mother of petitioner and considering the fact that he is the only child, there being no one else in the family to look after middle aged lady (mother of petitioner) and old aged grandmother, petitioner is granted concession of interim bail for a period of 16 days i.e. from 30.09.2025 to 16.10.2025, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner is directed to surrender to the concerned Jail Authorities on 17.10.2025.

4. Disposed of in the above terms.
