The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the due salary and retiral benefits to the petitioner alongwith interest at the rate of eighteen per cent per annum.

2. Pursuant to last order dated 25.03.2025, Treasury Officer, Faridabad-Sanjay Singh, is present in Court and has informed that pensionary benefits have been released to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that all due pensionary benefits have been released to the petitioner. He, however, submits that the petitioner is entitled to interest on account of delayed payment of salary and pensionary benefits and may be permitted to make a representation in that regard to the respondent.



4. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to make an appropriate application seeking payment of interest on account of delay, if any, in release of salary and pensionary benefits.
