**ANIL KSHETARPAL, JUDGE (Oral)**

1. The present revision petition has been filed by the plaintiff to assail the correctness of the order passed on 06.09.2024, refusing him permission to reduce his claim.

2. Originally, the plaintiff filed a suit for recovery of Rs.31,06,53,780/-. The application under Order VII Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure (hereinafter referred to as 'CPC') was filed by the defendants in which directions were issued to pay ad-valorem court fee. Subsequently, the plaintiff filed an application for reducing his claim which has also been dismissed.

3. This Bench has heard the learned counsel representing the parties at length and with their able assistance perused the paper book.

4. The plaintiff is entitled to restrict his claim. The learned



counsel representing the petitioner submits that the plaintiff is restricting his claim to Rs.15,05,56,250/-, the principal amount, on which he will pay the court fee.

5. The learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the order passed by the court under Order VII Rule 11 CPC has become final.

6. This court has considered the submissions of the learned counsel representing the parties.

7. As already noticed, the plaintiff is entitled to restrict his claim. Hence, the revision petition is allowed. The impugned order passed by the trial court on 06.09.2024, is set aside. The plaintiff's claim is restricted to Rs.15,05,56,250/-, the principal amount, as on the date of filing of the suit.

8. As prayed for by the learned counsel representing the petitioner, three months' time is granted to make good the deficiency in payment of court fee, failing which his plaint shall stand rejected.

9. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
