1. The Family Court has ordered the husband to pay interim maintenance @ ₹12,000/- per month to his wife. Two cross revision petitions have been filed, one by the husband and another by the wife. The husband prays for reduction in the amount of interim maintenance, whereas

the wife prays for its enhancement.

2. It is admitted by the learned counsel representing the parties that the proceedings in the divorce petition have come to fag end and now the case is fixed for final arguments. The learned counsel representing the parties have also disclosed that a transfer application has been filed in which the proceedings have been stayed. A period of nearly six years have elapsed.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid fact that the proceedings in the divorce petition have come to fag end, hence, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere.

4. With the observations made above, both the revision petitions are disposed of.

5. The miscellaneous application(s) pending, if any, shall stand disposed of.
