The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.77 dated 29.07.2025, under Sections 217, 125, 25, 26, 324 (4), 61 (2) of the BNS, 2023 and under Section 25, 27, 54, and 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 27.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

3. Learned State counsel on instruction from the Investigating Officer, corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of

investigation.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. Since the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is **allowed** and the interim order dated 27.08.2025 is made absolute.

6. However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 482 (2) BNSS.
