1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of
anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.133, dated
27.09.2024, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, 1860,
registered at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.



2. Vide order dated 22.05.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 22.05.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

4. Status report by way of an affidavit of Riputapan Singh Sandhu, PPS, Superintendent of Police-SDPO City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed by learned State counsel today in the Court and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed the same.

6. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdial Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

7. In view of the above, interim order dated 22.05.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS.
