1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.36, dated 17.03.2025, under Section(s) 109, 190, 191(3) OF bns, 2023, and under Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

2. On the very outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that inadvertently, he could not incorporate in the title as well as the prayer clause about the offence added later on by the prosecution i.e. Section 118 (2) of the BNS. Therefore, he be allowed to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to file a fresh one, with complete and better particulars.

3. Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as sought and recorded here above.
