1. This is the second petition under Section 482 of the B.N.S.S., whereby, the petitioner has sought the relief of him being granted the concession of pre-arrest bail, in Criminal Complaint No.17 of 2021, titled as "Serious Fraud Investigation Office Vs. SRS Limited and others".
