1. The petitioner incarcerated in the FIR captioned above has come up before this Court under Section 483 BNSS, 2023, for the grant of regular bail along with an application for ad-interim bail in the FIR captioned above on medical grounds.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is suffering from T2DM with hypertension with CVA-Right MCA infarct with left sides hemiplegia and during custody, no proper care and treatment is being provided to the petitioner. Counsel further submits that petitioner be allowed interim bail for at least one month, and he undertakes to comply with every condition imposed by this Court and restrict his prayer qua interim bail.

3. The petitioner's counsel submits that the petitioner would have no objection whatsoever to any stringent conditions that this Court may impose, including that if the petitioner repeats the offense or commits any non-bailable offense which provides for a sentence of imprisonment for more than seven years, or commits any offence under the NDPS Act, where the quantity involved is more than half of the intermediate, or commercial quantity, or violates S. 19, or 24, or 27-A of the NDPS Act, the State may file an application to revoke this bail before the concerned Special Judge or Sessions Court

having jurisdiction over this FIR, which shall have the authority to cancel this bail, and may do so at their discretion, to which the petitioner shall have no objection.

4. The State's Counsel could not oppose the authenticity of the medical record of the petitioner.

5. Medical report of the petitioner is handed over by the State, which is taken on record. Relevant portion of the report reads as follows:-

*“He was remain admitted in PGIMS Rohtak, in Cardiology department from we.f 26/05/2025 to 28/05/2025 with diagnosis of Diabetes type 2/Hypertension/ cerebrovascular abnormality (CVA) with left hemiparesis with right facial nerve palsy with right fronto temporal gangliocapsular infarct with left ICA 70-80% stenosis. Planned for Carotid end arterectomy patient was prescribed treatment and advised to followup in Neurology and CTVS department and to followup in Cardiology OPD after two weeks. He was again referred to PGIMS, Rohtak in Cardiology department on dated 9/6/2025. The treatment prescribed by the specialist doctor of Cardiology department is being provided to him regularly.*

*On 12/07/2025 he was being referred to PGIMS, Rohtak in Neurology department for further opinion & followup and He was admitted there on same day. It is further submitted that at present patient is being admitted PGIMS Rohtak since 12.07.2025.”*

6. Medical history of the petitioner shows that his treatment is going on, and for follow-up treatment, he requires some time and is entitled to interim bail.

7. Given the above, this court considers it appropriate on humanitarians ground to grant him time to recoup and take care of his health and is inclined to grant him interim bail **until 11 AM on 11.08.2025.**

8. Given above, provided the petitioner is not required in any other case, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail in the FIR captioned above till the date and time mentioned above, subject to furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Court and due to unavailability before any nearest Ilaqa Magistrate/duty Magistrate. Before accepting the surety, the concerned Court must be satisfied that if the accused fails to appear, such surety can produce the accused.

9. While furnishing a personal bond, the petitioner shall mention the following

personal identification details:

1.	AADHAR number	
2.	Passport number (If available) and when the attesting officer/court considers it appropriate or considers the accused a flight risk.	
3.	Mobile number (If available)	
4.	E-Mail id (If available)	

10. This interim limited period bail is conditional, with the foundational condition being that if the petitioner repeats the offense or commits any non-bailable offense which provides for a sentence of imprisonment for more than seven years, or commits any offence under the NDPS Act, where the quantity involved is more than half of the intermediate, or commercial, or violates S. 19, or 24, or 27-A of the NDPS Act, the State shall file an application to revoke this bail before the Special Judge/ Sessions Court having jurisdiction over this FIR, which shall have the authority to cancel this bail, and as per their discretion, they may cancel this bail.

11. Any observation made hereinabove is neither an expression of opinion on the merits of the case nor shall the trial Court advert to these comments.

12. The petitioner shall surrender in the prison from where he was released, on **11.08.2025 at 11 A.M.**

13. *There would be no need for a certified copy of this order for furnishing bonds, and any Advocate for the Petitioner can download this order along with case status from the official web page of this Court and attest it to be a true copy. In case the attesting officer wants to verify the authenticity, they can also verify it and may download and use the downloaded copy for attesting bonds.*

14. **CRM-17073-2025 is allowed and main petition is disposed of.** It is clarified that no application for extension of interim bail shall be filed in the present petition. However, if the petitioner's health does not improve, he shall be permitted to file a fresh petition for regular bail without surrendering. All pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
