Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 12.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-23053-2023 titled as “Mahabir Singh and another vs. State of Haryana and others”, vide which the direction was issued to the respondent “... to look into the legal notice dated 01.09.2023/06.09.2023 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.”

In pursuance of order dated 15.5.2025 passed by this Court, learned State counsel has filed the Compliance Report dated 13.8.2025 by way of affidavit of Shri Swapnil Ravindra Patil, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar. The same is taken on record. Copy



thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that necessary compliance has been made while passing a Speaking Order dated 11.8.2025 (Annexure R-1); thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the said fact and admits that the order dated 12.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with and a Speaking Order dated 11.8.2025 (Annexure R-1) has been passed by the respondent-authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the above, the present contempt petition may be disposed of, however, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the aforesaid Speaking Order, as per law.

Accordingly, the present petition stands **disposed of**, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the aforesaid Speaking Order dated 11.8.2025 (Annexure R-1) as per law, if so advised.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
