The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to count/treat break period occurred during *ad hoc* service as duty period and release due arrears of said period to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the second respondent is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 22.10.2024, Annexure P-6, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 22.10.2024, will be decided by the second respondent/Director, Elementary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
