1. This application has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for placing on record original affidavit of petitioner No.1.
2. In view of the averments made in the application, same is allowed and original affidavit of petitioner No.1 regarding conversion of religion from Muslim to Hindu is taken on record as Annexure P-6, subject to all just exceptions.

3. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have married against the wishes of private respondents and they claim themselves to be major and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from the private respondents. They have placed on record marriage certificate (Annexure P-1) to substantiate their claim. The petitioners have also submitted a representation dated 21.06.2025 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 but no action has been taken so far.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

6. Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice for the official respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to supply a copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

7. Without commenting on validity of the marriage allegedly performed by the petitioners and entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of this petition with direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-5) within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a



certified copy of this order and grant them protection, if there is any threat to their life and liberty. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any committed by them.
