CM No.521-CII of 2014 is allowed. Rejoinder to the reply file by respondent No.2 is taken on record.

By virtue of order dated 1.5.2012, the non-compliance of which has been alleged, it was desired by this Court that the respondents shall take a conscious decision on the availability of the pay scales and the effective date thereof by taking into consideration the claim of the petitioner as also any other representationist.

The needful has been done as has been indicated in the reply filed by the respondents even though this is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the order of this Court has been complied with, the rule against the respondents is discharged. The petitioner, however, would be at liberty to impugn the order passed by the respondents and put forward his claim in the eventuality of his having any grievance against the same.
