1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.10 dated 23.01.2025 registered under Sections 420 & 376(2)(n) of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Amargarh, District Malerkotla.
2. As per office report, service is complete. However, none has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2.
3. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Davinder Singh (PPS), Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Amargarh, District Malerkotla, on behalf of respondent No.1-State, has been filed in the Registry which is taken on record.
- 4.. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 05.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Gurpreet Kaur, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation. He further submits that final report under Section 193 of BNSS, 2023 has been presented by the police before the Trial Court on 21.03.2025.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.03.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
