Petitioner has filed criminal writ petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuing directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner so that no harm is caused to them by respondent Nos.4 to 12 on account of threatening and harassing petitioner and to take legal action on representation (Annexure P-2) given by petitioner against respondent Nos.4 to 12.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she has instructions to withdraw the instant petition, therefore, she withdraws the same.

In view of the statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. However, petitioner is given liberty to file afresh petition in case there is actual threat to the life and liberty of petitioner.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
