1. Status report dated 10.01.2025 filed in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tauru, District Nuh (Mewat) is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. Heard.
3. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in



compliance to the order dated 19.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions received from HC Manoj and while referring to para 3 of the status report filed by the State has submitted that the petitioner is not found involved in the present case and as such he is not required to be arrested in the present FIR. He has further admitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

6. Faced with this statement made by learned State counsel and also the averment made in the status report filed by the State, learned counsel for the petitioner has sought withdrawal of the petition at this stage.

7. In view of the above, petition stands dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
