Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.1 makes a categorical statement that the encroachment upon the passage/path in question has been demolished on 2.2.2015. Counsel further furnishes an undertaking that the debris which is on the spot would also be removed within a period of two weeks from today.

In the light of such categorical stand taken by the counsel, this Court is of the considered view that there has been substantial compliance of the directions dated 7.11.2012, passed by the Division Bench while disposing of CWP No.22150 of 2012.

Present contempt petition is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
