ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

The petitioner, who is wife of Devinder Singh, who had expired on 23.09.2024, has come up before this Court by filing the present petition under Section 379 BNSS 2023, for taking appropriate action against the respondent for committing the offence under Sections 227, 228, 229, 233, 236, 237, 246 of BNSS 2023, for submitting a false affidavit dated 28.10.2024 in CM No.19481-CII-2024 in FAO-M-152-2009.

2. In the nutshell, grievance of the petitioner is that after the death of petitioner's husband, respondent made a false application supported by affidavit under Order 22 Rule 3 CPC that he is only legal heir despite knowing fully well that petitioner-Gurmeet Kaur was his wife.

3. Mr. Arihant Jain, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent and waives service on his behalf.

4. Counsel appearing for the respondent submits that they did not dispute that petitioner is wife of late Devinder Singh, but matrimonial dispute had taken place

and certainly there was no malafide intention and absolutely not to grab any pensionary benefits and he is only nominee of late Devinder Singh, therefore in that capacity he filed the affidavit.

5. Given the facts and circumstances, no loss is caused to the petitioner. Consequently, no orders are required to pass in the present petition and the same is dismissed. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
