1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the official respondents to conduct the fair and proper investigation in case arising out of FIR No. 09, dated 09.05.2023, under Section 7, 7-A of Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 21.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) to the Special DGP-Chief Director Vigilance Bureau-respondent No.3 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.4 to look into the representation dated 21.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.4- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Vigilance Bureau, Bathinda to look into representation dated 21.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
