1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.195 dated 11.10.2024, under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

2. Vide order dated 24.07.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 24.07.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.



4. Learned State counsel has filed status report, which is taken on record. She, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, interim order dated 24.07.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
