Present petition has been filed under Section 528, BNSS, 2023, for quashing of order dated 07.11.2024 (Annexure P4) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur arising out of FIR No.187 dated 14.09.2021, under Sections 379-B, 323, 149, 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur, vide which the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner have been cancelled on account of non-appearance.

The relevant facts of the present case are that the petitioner is facing trial in the afore-said case and was granted regular bail by trial Court. Earlier he was regularly appearing before the learned trial Court. The petitioner absented on 07.11.2024 and his bail order as well as bail bonds and surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to State and he was ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that earlier the petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court and absence of the petitioner on 07.11.2024 was not intentional but was due to

the reason that as he was arrested in another FIR No.246 dated 19.10.2024, Police Station Bhawanigarh. The petitioner has now been granted bail in FIR No.246, as detailed above. Learned counsel has submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court. Therefore, the impugned order dated 07.11.2024 be set aside.

Heard.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the present case and taking note of the fact that trial of the case is likely to take time and no useful purpose is likely to be served by sending him behind the bars. Accordingly, impugned order dated 07.11.2024 is set aside. The petitioner is directed to surrender and appear before the trial Court within 10 days and on doing so, he would be released on bail on furnishing his fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Court concerned and with the undertaking to appear regularly before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and subject to depositing of Rs.6,000/- with DLSA, Sangrur.
