AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners have filed instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Section 528 BNSS, 2023 for issuing appropriate direction to learned Illaqa Magistrate, Bathinda for expeditious disposal of UCR-218-2023 (cancellation report) in FIR No.207 dated 27.11.2021 wherein cancellation report (Annexure P-4) was filed on 20.04.2023 and the matter remained pending for the last more than 2 years or any other direction which the Court may deem fit in the given facts and circumstances of the case.

2. Report has been received from the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda according to which the said cancellation report has been disposed of by giving direction to the Investigating agency to further investigate the matter as per law and Rules.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has also produced downloaded copy of order dated 11.09.2025 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda. He states that since cancellation report has been disposed of, therefore, present petition has rendered infructuous and accordingly withdraws the same.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn having rendered infructuous.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
