1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 08.01.2024 passed by this court in CWP-125-2024.

2. In compliance of order dated 08.01.2024, the counsel for respondents has placed on record office order dated 20.05.2024, which is taken on record. The Registry is directed to scan the same and make it part of the soft copy of the case.

3. The counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by rejecting the claim of the petitioner vide speaking order dated 20.05.2024. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.



5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
