Learned State counsel representing the respondent, on instructions, submits that the speaking order has been passed as regards claim of the petitioner and the payment in terms thereof shall be released within 02 weeks from today.

2. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

3. Dismissed as not pressed.

4. Rule discharged.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.

6. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that



eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

7. It is also made clear that as regards the deductions made by the respondent, if any, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail its remedy, in accordance with law.
