

installments to pay the amount is a reasonable relief granted to the street vendors in the facts and circumstances of the present case.

4. We do not find any error in the order of the Appellate Authority. In case the petitioners fail to avail themselves of the remedy granted to them by the Appellate Authority, the petitioners are themselves to be blamed.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners would clear all outstanding amount within a month from today.

6. If that be so, we deem it appropriate to grant one last opportunity to the petitioners to clear all outstanding dues towards the vending fee. The chart clarifying the outstanding amount has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioners. If such amount is paid within a month from today, the same shall be accepted by the respondent(s) and the licenses of the petitioners shall be restored, failing which the licenses of the petitioners shall remain cancelled.

7. In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of.
