Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to proceed in accordance with law and conduct a fair and impartial enquiry into the complaint dated 28.10.2024 to the respondents by the petitioner, in which the statement of the petitioner has been recorded as complainant, and cognizable offences under Sections 318(4) and 61(2) of BNS, are disclosed to have been committed by the accused persons mentioned in the complaint.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that for the redressal of his grievance the petitioner had filed the complaint even before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur however, no action has been taken on the same till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. He, at the outset, on instructions from ASI Jebra Singh, submits that the complaint was enquired into and finding no substance in the same, it was filed.
