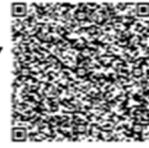

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, praying for quashing of FIR No.803 dated 14.08.2015 (**P-1**), under Sections 147, 323, 325, 452 & 506 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station, Sadar Hisar, District Hisar, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, including judgment of conviction & order of sentence dated 11/12.06.2019, on the basis of compromise effected between the parties, i.e. petitioners as well as respondent Nos.2 & 3.

2. Concededly, an appeal (CRA/324/2019) against the aforesaid judgment & order, filed on behalf of petitioner Nos.1 & 3, namely, Naresh and Pardeep @ Deepak, respectively, is pending before learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar; whereas, another appeal

(CRA-410/2019) on behalf of petitioner No.2-Vinod, is pending before learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Judge, Special Court for Heinous Crime Against Women, Hisar.

3. In view of the above, after arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all their pleas before learned Appellate Court(s), and also to move an appropriate application for bringing on record the compromise deed as an additional evidence in accordance with law.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case, in any manner.
