Affidavit of respondent No.1 is filed in Court and a copy is given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he had sent a cheque of ₹55561/- towards external/internal development charges to HUDA. The said amount is received as stated by Mr. Dinesh Kumar, ADA, who is present in Court on behalf of HUDA.

Mr.Narwal submits that six meters passage, as stated in para 3 of the affidavit is provided to the petitioner and is shown in the attached plan (Annexure R-2) and necessary correction would be made in the original plan/record for which he prays for one month time to do the needful.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and examining the record, this petition is disposed of as having become infructuous while granting two months' time to the respondents to show the plot of the petitioner as well as six meters rasta, in the original record/map.
