By way of present revision petition, the petitioner is challenging the impugned order dated 04.10.2024 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Nakodar, District Jalandhar in Civil Suit No.730-2018 whereby the learned trial Court has granted 'NIL' opportunity to the petitioner for conducting cross-examination upon PW1-Dalbir Singh on account of non-appearance of learned counsel representing the petitioner before the learned trial Court.

Learned counsel submits that the said reasoning of the learned trial Court is patently incorrect as a bare perusal of the impugned order dated 04.10.2024 (at page 16 of the paper book) shows that the presence of the counsel for the defendants, namely, Shri Varun Sharma, Advocate is marked in the said order. Learned counsel also refers to another zimni order dated 29.11.2024 (at page



21 of the paper book) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Nakodar, wherein presence of the counsel for the petitioner is marked.

Heard.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is being disposed of without issuing Notice of Motion to the respondents as that will only further delay the matter; and with the direction to the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Nakodar to grant one effective opportunity to the petitioner to cross-examine the witness i.e. PW-1-Dalbir Singh, however, subject to payment of Rs.20,000/- as costs to be deposited within two weeks from today in the “Poor Patients’ Welfare Fund of the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh”.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
