Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 09.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-22721-2024 titled as “Bansi Lal vs. State of Haryana and another”, vide which *direction was issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 25.4.2022 (Annexure P-7) expeditiously, in accordance with law.*

As per office report, Compliance Report dated 04.6.2025 by way of affidavit of Dr. Sumitra Misra, IAS Financial Commissioner Revenue & Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Revenue and Disaster Management Department has already been filed.



Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 15.4.2025 annexed with the Compliance Report as Annexure R-1 by the Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Revenue and Disaster Management Department, Chandigarh; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives in the present petition, therefore, the present petition stands **disposed of**.
