1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 153 dated 02.06.2021, under Sections 302 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dujana, District Jhajjar.

2. As per the allegations in the FIR, which was lodged by the petitioner's brother, Deepak, petitioner left his house following a quarrel with his mother (now deceased). Thereafter, he is alleged to have re-entered the house through the adjoining residence of his cousin, Dilbag. It is further alleged that the petitioner assaulted his mother by giving blows on her head with a heavy wooden log. When the deceased raised an alarm, the complainant's sister-in-law (Bhabhi) intervened to rescue her, upon which the petitioner fled from the spot.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that initially, the FIR was registered against both the petitioner and his wife; however, during the course of investigation, the petitioner's wife was found to be

innocent by the investigating agency. Counsel also submits that petitioner is in custody for the past four years, thus, prays for grant of regular bail.

4. In view of the serious nature of the offence, wherein the petitioner is accused of having murdered his own mother, this Court is of the opinion that mere prolonged incarceration cannot be a ground for granting bail. Considering the gravity of the allegations, present petition is hereby **dismissed**
