1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for setting aside the order dated 05.12.2023 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar in case bearing No.CRA/363/2023 dated 05.12.2023 titled as Amandeep Singh Vs. Shubh Karman Singh etc vide which the petitioner was directed to deposit 20% of the amount of compensation awarded by the learned appellate Court.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the order dated 15.10.2024, an amount equal to 20% of the compensation has been deposited as directed by the learned Appellate Court. He further submits that the Appellate Court be directed not to release the said amount to the complainant.
3. When this Court posed question about Section 148A of the NIA which provides for the payment of compensation to the complainant-victim as a statutory provision and petitioner can reclaim as per the provision, in case, he found innocent. Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
4. Given above, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn. Since, the petitioner already complied with the direction to deposit the asked amount 20% of compensation amount, as such, order of suspension of sentence passed by the learned appellate Court is made absolute. All the pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
