HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned State counsel relies upon a speaking order dated 15.01.2025 passed by the respondent to contend that the petitioners have been accorded the benefit of promotion to the post of Head Masters, however, the relevant date shall be fixed on finalization of roaster point which is going to be concluded within four weeks from today. Learned State counsel further on instructions from Sh. Virender Dahiya, Asstt. Director, Secondary Education Department, Haryana assures that the necessary orders regarding seniority position of the petitioner shall be passed within two weeks thereafter.

2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
