1. This contempt petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating proceedings against the respondent for non compliance and wilful disobedience of the order dated 22.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CRM-M-2962-2025, whereby the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, was directed to look into the representation dated 01.03.2024, appended as Annexure P-5 with the supra criminal miscellaneous and to decide the same, in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order, after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

2. Mr. Akhil Kamra, AAG, Punjab, having been served an advance copy of the petition, puts in appearance on behalf of the



respondent and submits that the instant petition is misconceived and is a result of lack of proper information and instructions. He further submits that in compliance to the order dated 22.01.2025 (Annexure P-5), the petitioner was afforded an opportunity of hearing and thereafter, a speaking order has been passed on 03.03.2025, a copy whereof has been furnished in Court. The same is taken on record.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
