1. Present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner and further not to dispense with his service during pendency of the present petition.

2. At this stage, Mr. Sunil Kalyan, Advocate appears on behalf of the respondents and files Memorandum of Appearance in the Court today, which is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place of the case file. At the very outset, he submits that the petitioner has mentioned particulars of *CWP-7614-2024* titled as *Surinder Singh Vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. and others* in the index of instant writ petition and the

same has been dismissed along with a bunch of petitions by this Court vide judgment dated 22.09.2025, while dealing with the issue of regularization, as prayed for by the petitioner. As such, the controversy involved in the present petition is squarely covered by the judgment passed in *Surinder Singh*'s case (*supra*) and learned counsel for the present petitioner represented the petitioner(s) in some of the writ petitions.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to controvert the fact that similar issue raised in the present petition regarding regularization of identically circumstanced part-time employees has been considered and decided by this Court, while dismissing the bunch of writ petitions in *Surinder Singh*'s case (*supra*).

4. In view of the above, present petition is also dismissed.
