The present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.0030 dated 27.05.2023 under Section 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, (Section 406 IPC added later on), registered at Women Police Station, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar, Punjab (Annexure P-1), along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 has submitted that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the parties have already compromised the matter before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and a separate petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise has been filed.
