This petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 for taking the departmental and legal action against respondents No.5 & 6 and other police officials of Police Station Division No.8, Jalandhar. Petitioner has also prayed for transfer of the investigation in FIR No.45 dated 22.02.2025, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act (Section 29 NDPS Act added later on), at Police Station Division No.8, Jalandhar District Jalandhar to some other independent probe agency or to constitute SIT in the aforesaid case.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has preferred a representation/complaint dated 12.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, but no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.4-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar,

to look into his representation/complaint dated 12.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only at this stage.
4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and carefully perused the material available on record.
6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to consider and decide the representation/complaint dated 12.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
