1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners for directions to the respondents No.2 to 6 to protect their life and liberty from the respondents No.7 and 8.
2. The learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that the petitioner has filed the representation dated 03.10.2025 (Annexure P-1) before the respondent No.2. The learned counsel prays for disposing of the present petition by issuing directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the abovementioned representation within a stipulated time.
3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 6 only.



4. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 6/State, and waives service.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is hereby directed that by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of this order, the representation of petitioner (Annexure P-1) be disposed of either by the Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh (respondent No.2) or, on assignment by him, by any other police officer not below the rank of Senior Superintendent of Police. It is however clarified that no finding is being returned, by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of abovesaid representation. The respondent No.2 shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of representation of the petitioner and make an independent decision at his own level.

6. In view of above, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
