1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.0150 dated 20.12.2023, registered under Sections 365, 366, 346 and 34 IPC at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners on the basis of compromise dated 14.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Learned State counsel submits that co-accused namely, Harjot Singh is not party in the present petition and in view of a Division Bench judgment of this Court in *Rakesh Das v. State of Haryana, 2024(4) Law Herald 3141*, petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of partial compromise, is not maintainable.
