**SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):**

This is second petition for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner.

The first petition was dismissed on 11.09.2024.

2. This petition has been filed in the backdrop of the fact that during the course of trial qua co-accused the complainant has not supported the prosecution version. The record reveals that the petitioner has been successfully absconding for a period of more than 1 and ½ years despite dismissal of his petition for anticipatory bail.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court, and that the petitioner would not like to press this petition for anticipatory bail, provided a direction is given to the learned trial Court to dispose of bail application of the petitioner in a time bound manner.

4. In view of above, the present petition is hereby dismissed as



withdrawn. However, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within one month. If he surrenders before the learned trial Court within the stipulated time, the learned trial Court shall dispose of the bail application, if moved by the petitioner, within a period of one week from the date of filing of such application positively. It is however clarified that the learned trial Court in the exercise of its discretion shall be at liberty to take the petitioner in judicial custody or impose penalty under Section 491 of BNSS (erstwhile Section 446 of Cr.P.C).
